BACK TO SCHOOL REGATTA NOVEMBER 19 & 20, 2011

The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2009 - 2012, by Class Rules for the participating classes, the rules of the GYA Regulations for Sanctioned Events and the regatta Sailing Instructions. The SI's will be available at registration.

Classes:

Capdevielle & Open Scots (Flying Scot Sailing Association Cajun Country Championship within Open Scots class), Laser, Laser Radial, Sunfish, Lido 14's, Optimist (red, white, blue and green fleets), 420's, Finns, PHRF Non-Spinnaker, PHRF Spinnaker and/or any other class with three or more boats. Boats with fewer than 3 per class will compete in Portsmouth Handicap Class.

Entry fee: (No fee for Capdevielle)

Multi-crewed boats \$35.00 for US Sailing members \$40.00 for non-US Sailing Members.

Single-handed boats \$30.00 for US Sailing members \$35.00 for non-US Sailing Members.

PHRF \$20.00 sailing Saturday only

Snacks will be served on the water Saturday only. Optis will have lunch dockside before leaving the harbor.

Capdevielle and Open Scots will attempt three (3) races, with one (1) race constituting a regatta.

Optis will attempt as many races as possible.

All other classes will attempt 4 races. PHRF Saturday only will attempt two (2) races with one (1) race constituting a regatta.

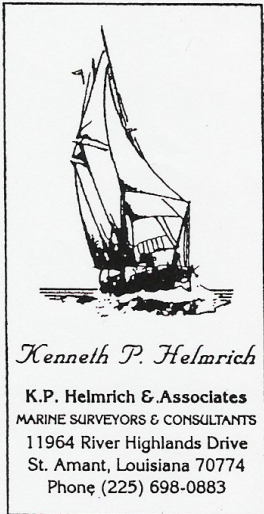

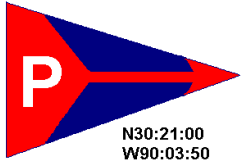

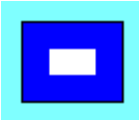
