



From the Commodore:

Be it weeding the gardens, painting railings, servicing our floating assets or Friday Food, we have to pay to play! There will always be challenges and adjustments that the club will have to make.

Please remember that this is YOUR club, and the board members and their families are making a huge commitment to do their best to manage your club and create a safe, fun, and respectable place to serve on your behalf. Remember these folks have real jobs and lives outside of PYC. It's a group volunteer effort and we need your physical help or your money to make it happen. I am proud to be handing over the helm to Commodore Richard Jones. Dick has done a fabulous job in the last 2 years marketing our club and will do a great job as your advocate in the year to come.
