HOUSE AND GROUNDS– RICHARD DENUNZIO

The May rainy weather postponed the start of several projects including; the acid staining of the first floor and elevated areas, the repair of the bulkhead outer perimeter wall, and the painting of the railing. We hope to be able to acid stain and seal the concrete the week of June 29th to July 3rd. weather permitting. The repair work on the bulkhead will be postponed till the fall when the water level is lower. The painting of the railing is about 75% complete and will be an on-going project till completion.

I've ordered the fluorescent lens covers and clips for the covered sail boat storage area. I also ordered the PVC stainless pipe hangers to replace the rusted ones. I have also started to paint the PVC (white) pipes with a stone gray color that seems to blend in with the concrete floor above.

John Williams and Jason Powell worked this past week end to May 16th and 23rd to run the electrical and plumbing to three pole location for new flood lights, outdoor receptacles, and hose bibbs at the dry boat storage /parking areas will be completed within the next to 10 days.

We will be working this week end to build the dingy floating dock on Saturday
