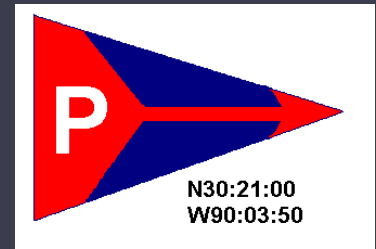

HOLIDAY "STAFF APPRECIATION" GIFT


Dear Members,

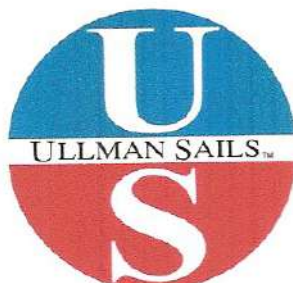
