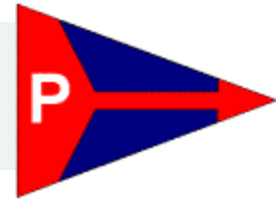

**COMMODORE'S CORNER- DICK JONES**

The Dog Days of August are here.

I want to thank all the members who attended the Semi Annual meeting. For those of you that missed the meeting we discussed the following major topics;

1. Location of the City of Mandeville's proposed public restrooms for the East end of the lake front. There are several proposed/suggested locations and the club's position is that we do not want the building located directly across the street facing the club. We have made our position known to the mayor and councilmen. Our preferred location would be close to the bayou and the boat launch. If you have any comments please express them to the mayor and the city council and let it be known that you are speaking for yourself and not representing the club's position.



2. The decline in volunteerism and the potential financial impact to the club. Tom Jarvis detailed the ongoing costs of maintaining the house and grounds and projects that are costly. While we have funds in the Capital Improvement account, we are required to keep a large portion of the fund in reserve to offset our insurance deductible and also maintain 2-3 months of operating income. Without volunteers to help offset the expenses we have to make choices and set priorities about what to repair and maintain. The pool has structural cracks that in the next year or so need to be repaired. One estimate is approx. \$12,000, repainting the exterior doors and the white railing is necessary, painting the underside of the building to enhance outside events, fence repairs, boatyard/boat storage repairs, and the list goes on. Marian Arrowsmith has volunteered to form a Volunteer Committee to reach out to the members to help. An additional option is to have a monthly fee dedicated to the cost of maintaining your club. This may be the best option looking long term. If the board approves this monthly fee it will have to be ratified by the members during the annual meeting.

3. The election of the nominating committee. The nominating committee will seek out qualified members to replace the three board members whose terms expire at the end of this year. If you are interested in becoming a board member please make intentions known to Brian Burke or the other committee members.

Paul, our long term bartender, has decided to move on to new opportunities. We will all miss Paul's bartending skills, specialty cocktails and food events. Please wish him well with his new opportunity. Nicole Cloen will take over the main responsibility for the bar management. Nicole has worked at the Lake House and comes to us highly recommended. Please make a point to welcome her the next time you are at the club. Jennifer Sillars and Trish Picone will also be backup bartenders as needed. Some of you may remember Trish as she was our bartender in the late 90's.

The White Summer Night was a great success with approx. 400 people attending. Thanks to Sylvia Schmidt and all of the volunteers helping to make this worthy event possible.

The club now has two kayaks for members to use. Thanks to Shannon Villemarette, the owner of Bayou Adventures in Lacombe and a recent new member, for giving the club a very good deal on the kayaks. Since the first of the year we have purchased a used sunfish, a 17ft. sail boat, and two kayaks. Last month we sold the Hydra Sport.

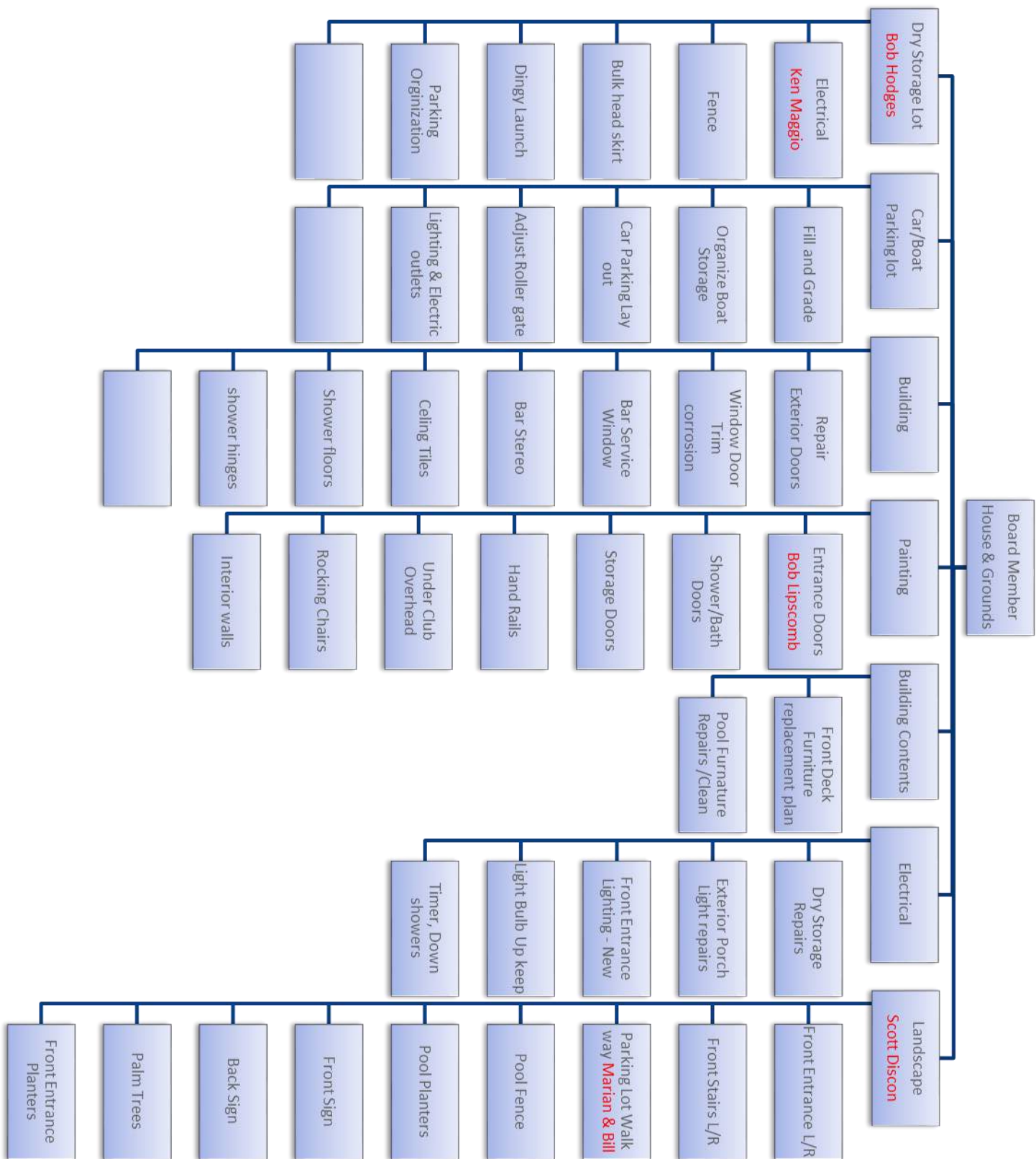
Thank you to those of you who understand the problem of long term sustainability of keeping up via volunteers and are in favor of contributing the cost of a couple of drinks a month to have it handled!
