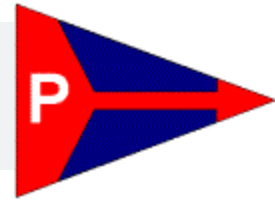

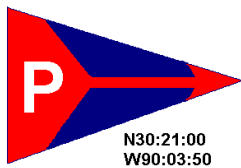
As I sit here considering what meaningful words I can present this month, I ponder what can I say that you have not already heard and I am tired of saying! So my feelings are:
