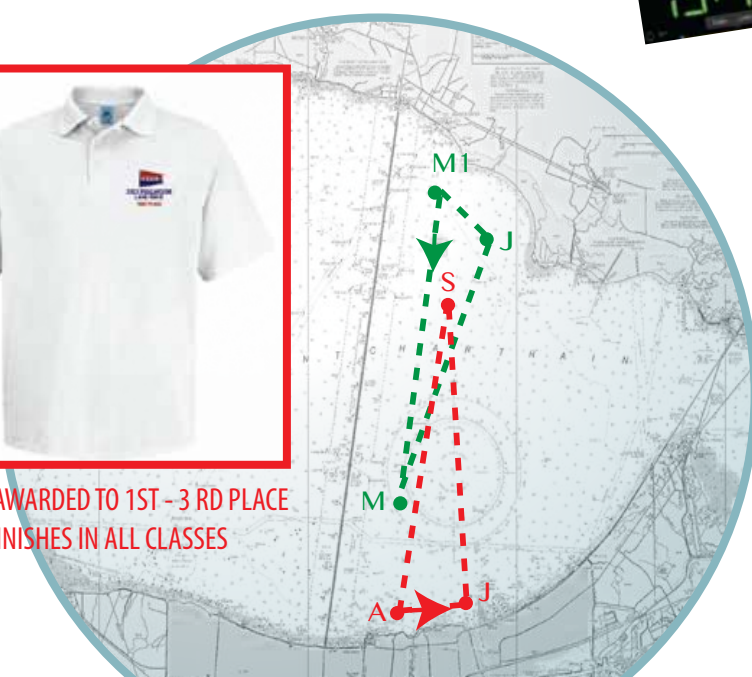

1. Rules

The 2017 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the general CSA Sailing Instructions will govern the race. (www.corinthians.org)

2. Divisions

PHRF-Spinnaker & Non-spinnaker: Divisions may be broken in to classes provided sufficient boats register.

3. Eligibility

Competitors: The race is open to all. Participating boats should have a current, signed GYA PHRF certificate. Boats without a PHRF certificate will be assigned a rating based upon similar boats. The assigned rating cannot be protested.

6. Race Course.....Use Radio Channel 69

This year we will have 2 courses . One for the Northshore and one for the Southshore. There will be NO COMMITTEE BOAT therefore use GPS time for your honorable start & finish.

Competitors should finish within 3 boat lengths of their respective finish mark. Course length is

28.5 + - NM [Runing lights are imperative this year due to boats crossing each others paths.]

Each skipper is reminded to comply with all applicable State and Federal safety regulations. Competitors shall monitor VHF Channel 69 during the race. Running lights must be displayed between sunset & dawn. Violators are subject to protest & disqualification. Crew required to wear PFD's ... **NO SINGLE HANDED RACING... MIN. 2 SAILERS PER BOAT**
