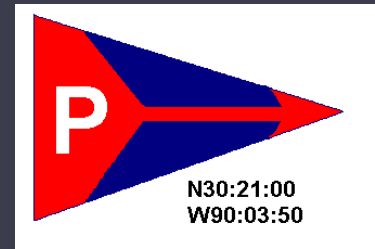

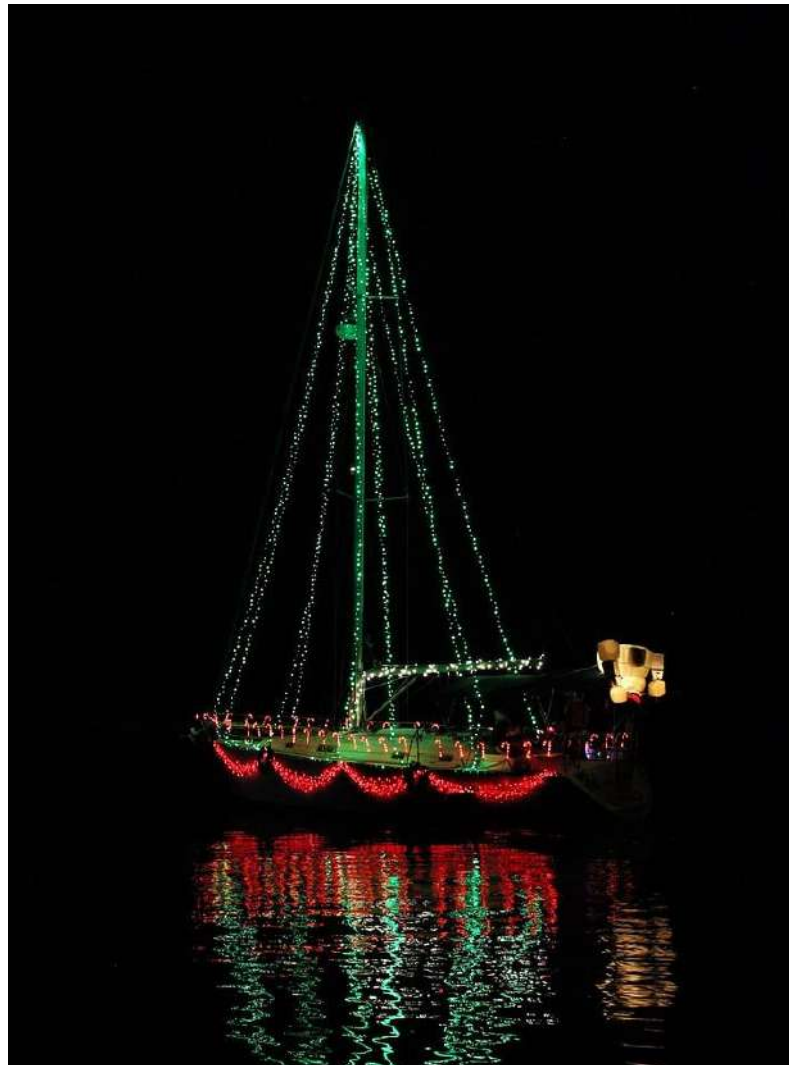


One Design

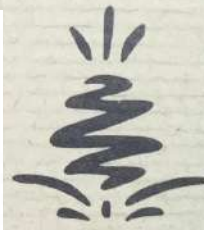
